You are invited to enjoy a weekend away with your President and fellow Probus members at the Hilton St. Annes Manor, part of the Hilton DoubleTree collection of accommodation and leisure facilities of swimming pool, Spa and Fitness Centre. The Hotel is sited in its own grounds in Wokingham, Berkshire.

The hotel does not offer 'packaged' entertainment. However, we will have a reserved area in the restaurant and also in the bar so will organise our own on one or two nights.

We have provisionally reserved 15 Standard rooms for the weekend away, some with separate walk-in shower and some with bath and shower over. We have also able to choose a ground floor room if you require. There are lifts to upper floors.

*Based on a 'Standard' room, £640 per couple or £475 for single occupancy, an Upgrade to a Deluxe room is £30 per room per night (£90 per couple) and the cost would then be £730 per couple. However, all upgrade requests will need to be referred to Hilton and will be subject to availability.

The above is inclusive of a 2 Hour private group cruise along the Thames with afternoon tea included.

Things to do near the Hotel.

On the Sunday we have a 2-hour boat trip from Windsor. This will include a cream tea on a boat exclusive to Christchurch Probus. It will depart at 1:30 pm from close to Eton Bridge in Windsor.

There is a choice of parking nearby with a choice of options; very close (Riverside Car Park – 2 minutes) is more expensive than a short walk (Alma Road – 5 minutes) but both offer a flat route suitable for wheelchairs etc.

If you wish to spend longer in Windsor there is lots to see, the Castle, the riverside, Eton college, the Long walk, with lots of choice of restaurants etc.

Boat Trip details

Departing from Windsor, this 2 hour round trip provides excellent views of Windsor Castle and Eton College. After passing Windsor Racecourse, the boat goes through Boveney Lock and past Sutherland Grange, The Willows, and Bray Film Studios. The boat then heads towards Oakley Court, Queen's Eyot and Monkey Island where the boat turns for the journey back to Windsor. Windsor 2 hour round trip Schedule Departs Windsor 13.30 Arrives Windsor 15.30 An afternoon cream tea of Two Fruit scones with Jam and Clotted Cream plus tea or coffee will accompany the trip.

For your other time (Saturday) the following options are available:

Ascot Racecourse is a 10-minute drive.

Head to Ascot for the final day of the flat racing season and their Beer festival. Details below https://www.ascot.com/horse-races-and-events/autumn-racing-weekend/saturday
Note: There is also racing on Friday if you want to travel early

Virginia Water (lakeside walks, totem pole, waterfall & Savill Gardens) is 25 minutes' drive.

Virginia Water is part of the Windsor Great Park estate. It has a 2-mile-long lake that you can walk around (5.25 miles). If your legs don't go that far, park in the car park on the A30 (GU25 4QF) and you have a much shorter walk to see the Totem pole, waterfall, and Leptis Magna ruins. Additionally for an extra fee there are the Savill Gardens, a 35-acre garden with woodlands and seasonal displays.

Henley Town (Rowing Museum) is 25 minutes' drive.

I can't offer you a race along the Henley regatta racecourse but it is a quaint old town with riverside walks and the River and Rowing Museum. The Sunday Times voted it as one of the best places to live in England,

Bracknell Shopping Centre is a 10-minute drive.

If the ladies (or gentlemen) fancy some shopping, then 'The Lexicon' in Bracknell offers an M&S and a Fenwick's as the centre piece of a large shopping centre with many restaurants and cafes.

Wokingham Town is less than a mile from the Hotel.

A short walk takes you to a small village with a town hall centrepiece with a choice of cafes and a few restaurants.

Further afield

Wokingham and Bracknell have railway stations from which you can head to Reading (25 minutes) or London Waterloo (70 minutes)
